Water Gilding Demonstration & Workshop
Saturday, February 6, 2016
10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**



Alan Shuptrine of **Shuptrine's Gold Leaf Designs and Art Gallery** in Chattanooga, Tennessee, will provide a hands-on demonstration on the centuries old method of water gilding. He will discuss the details of Old World gilding methods, and how these methods are applied in the restoration and conservation of historical items. A powerpoint presentation will be shown, followed by a demonstration of actual water gilding, sgraffito designs, agate burnishing, and patination of the finish. He will also provide examples of different gilded and restored finishes on corner samples, frames, and other gilded objects. Through his company, **Shuptrine's Gold Leaf Designs**, he and his wife Bonny have worked with museums, galleries, private art collectors, and artists nationwide. Students will be able to experiment with the techniques and create their own small gilded objects to take home with them. **Skill Level: Beginner to Advanced.**

Shuptrine's desire to pursue a career in the arts grew out of his natural inclination and influence of his father, the late Hubert Shuptrine, a nationally recognized watercolor realist. Born in 1963 in Chattanooga, Tennessee, Shuptrine's pursuit of the arts included schooling at The Baylor School, The University of the South, and The University of Tennessee. Having lived in more than 20 cities, mostly in the South, Alan's genre is naturally southern. And like his father, Alan prefers Realism with highly detailed and dramatic landscapes and figurative paintings. His influences include the works of his father, Hubert Shuptrine, Charles Prendergast, Stephen Scott Young, Andrew Wyeth, Winslow Homer, and John Singer Sargent. Shuptrine's work can be seen in many public and private collections and he has won several national and regional awards. He is an active member of the Society of Gilders, The American Institute of Conservation, The Salmagundi Club, The Tennessee Watercolor Society, The Southern Watercolor Society, The American Watercolor Society, The National Watercolor Society, and is the founder of The Master Craftsman's Society.
