Watercolor, 4 Fridays April 17, May 1, 8, 15 from 10 a.m.-1 p.m.

- **Watercolor brushes:** (Student grade is acceptable.)

1" Flat Wash Sabeline, synthetic or blend

#2, #6, #12 Rounds Sabeline, synthetic or blend

- **Watercolor Paper:** (Student grade is acceptable.)

Small tablet of Strathmore or Arches 10"x12" or 12"x16". Other watercolor paper will be discussed at the first day of class.

- **Watercolor Tubes:** (Such brands as Grumbacher Academy Watercolors, Winsor Newton, etc.) (Student grade is acceptable.)

Scarlett Lake Vermillion Alizarin Crimson

Burnt Umber or Burn Sienna

Cerulean Blue

Ultramarine Blue

Sap Green or Viridian Green

Raw Sienna

- **Watercolor Palette:** Approx. 11" x 16" white plastic tray.

- **One piece of foam core board at least—20" x 24"** available at any art supply store or framing store used for backing or support for the watercolor paper. Paper Towels

- Materials supplied by Museum Academy – pencils: #2 or B lead, kneaded eraser, plastic water container
