One of my strongest assets is problem-solving and that is how I fell in love with painting. I found a lot of pleasure trying to learn to see big shapes, values, color, edges, and composition. To me, art is simply a geometry problem: you are given a canvas and an idea, then you go through the steps to prove your creation connects with someone.

As you learn and grow as a painter, you will want to challenge yourself with new endeavors. Painting is learning how to see and achieve what your eye can discern. During COVID-19, I set goals to survive the "new normal," which one of those goals was to improve my skills as an artist. I read, watched videos, and painted with a purposeful intent to sharpen my process and push my artwork to grow to a new level.

I am an equestrian and I have always been told to paint what you know. I love to paint figures such as horses in motion, which requires working with edges to make the viewer think the figure is in motion.
