(Three) cotton or linen stretched canvas. Best 16"x 20" or larger. Any size is acceptable.

Acrylic or Oil Paints: Titanium White, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Raw Umber, Cadmium Yellow Light, Raw Umber – suggested colors. Any brand.

Kleenex Viva Paper Towels

Odorless mineral spirits such as Mona Lisa or Gamblin are good brands. Small container for mineral spirits.

Three brushes in Bristle No 6, No 8, No 12 Filbert or Flat. Preferably both but either will do.

Gloves if desired. Personal preference.

Any photo any subject for your reference painting. Still life set-up by the instructor.
