Supply List

- 11 x 15 inches or smaller any brand watercolor paper 140lb cold press paper (a few sheets)
- Small (#6 & #8) round watercolor brushes
- Large (#10 & #14) round watercolor brushes
- 1.5" fan brush brush (inexpensive nylon)
- 2" hake brush
- watercolor palette: approximately 11"x16" white plastic tray
- One piece of foam core board at least – 20"x24" available at any art supply store or framing store.
- #2 pencil with eraser
- paper towels
- masking tape or watercolor tape
- misting bottle
- hairdryer
- Frisket (latex mask) Alan prefers Incredible White brand, but you can bring whichever one you prefer as long as it is not tinted. Available at Hobby Lobby and Michael's.
- Square pick-up for removing frisket
- Watercolor pigment in 5ml: Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Cerulean Blue, Burnt Sienna, Permanent Alizarin Crimson, Yellow Ochre, Aureolin Yellow, Hooker's Green, and Sepia

Paper towels; #2 or B lead pencils; kneaded erasers; containers for water (for classroom use)
