This year marks the 36th annual **Youth Art Month (YAM)** exhibition of K-12 student artwork at the Huntsville Museum of Art. The **YAM, Juried Art Teachers' Biennial, and Congressional Art Competition** winning entry (**CAC**) exhibitions will be on view **March 12 – April 23, 2023** while **Visual Arts Achievement Program (VAA)** exhibition will be on view **March 12, 2023**. The YAM opening and the VAA and Congressional Art Competition awards presentation will take place on **Sunday, March 12, 2023**.

This exhibition not only showcases the exuberance and vitality of children's art, but also underscores the importance of art as an essential subject in a students' curriculum. Great art teachers are dedicated to educating students about art history, art criticism, aesthetics, and studio production and ensuring that students are exposed to a variety of art techniques, artists, and materials. A qualified, certified art teacher is an essential component in providing that all students receive the best art education possible.

All Homeschool organizations K-12 artwork will undergo a jury process to determine selection for exhibition.

The National Art Education Association (NAEA), Alabama Art Education Association (AAEA), Alabama State Department of Education, Alabama Arts Alliance (AAA), and the Huntsville-Madison County Art Education Association (HMCAEA) all endorse **Youth Art Month** in recognition of quality student artwork inspired by certified art teachers in the classroom.

Each art teacher may submit **1** work for the **jurying process** for the homeschools and District V. All school entries should be kept together and presented in a portfolio or box. **Please attach entry form to the back of the artwork.**

1. **Entries may be two-dimensional (Maximum 20"x 24")** or **three-dimensional to fit on a pedestal.**
2. Work should be selected based on quality, creativity, and presentation. Entries not meeting these standards will not be accepted.
3. **No Xerox, ditto, copied, or traced works will be accepted for exhibition in YAM 2023.**
(Defined as a work of art that is copied from a published photograph, magazine, book illustration, we site, other artwork, or by another person.)
As the art teacher, I further give my permission for publication of my student's work for publicity and archival purposes only, both in print and on-line. The Huntsville Museum of Art is not responsible for loss, damage or breakage.
4. **No group works** will be accepted.
5. Artwork **will not contain organic materials** (i.e. food products).

Works will be accepted here at the Museum Academy Studio I located on the pondside at Big Spring Park on **Monday, February 13, 2023 from 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m.** Look for **directional signs.** **No entries will be accepted after these times.** (You may also submit your entries early by dropping them off at our **Admissions Desk in the Museum Lobby.**)
