As part of **YAM 2023**, we will once again have the **Juried Art Teachers' Biennial** Exhibition. I would like to take this opportunity to give you some guidelines.

- 1. YAM 2023, including the Juried Art Teachers' Biennial Exhibition, will open on Sunday, March 12, 2023.
- 2. The artwork must have been executed since the last Juried Art Teachers' Biennial Exhibition of 2021. You may submit up to 2 entries for consideration.
- 3. We will use a panel of art professionals to select the pieces for the exhibition.
- 4. Works may be two-dimensional or three-dimensional to fit on a pedestal or to be hung on the wall. The Museum prefers artwork to be framed with Plexiglas due to safety issues in the Museum, if applicable with the art medium. However, if you already have your artwork framed in glass, we will accept your piece for submittal.
- 5. **No size restrictions** but please be mindful of the **limited space** that will be used in the gallery.
