## Master Artist Workshop Watercolor Floral with Alan Shuptrine November 1 & 2, 2024

## **Supply List**

- 11 X 15 inches or smaller of cold press watercolor paper, #140 or heavier, 2 sheets minimum
- #6-#8 round watercolor brush
- #10-#14 round watercolor brush
- 1.5" fan brush (inexpensive nylon)
- #1-#2 rigger (liner/script) brush
- Hake brush or large flat
- Watercolor palette (Alan uses a 10" porcelain palette)
- #2 pencil with eraser
- Paper Towels
- Misting bottle (Alan uses a fine continuous spray misting bottle)
- Hairdryer (optional)
- Frisket latex mask (Alan uses Incredible White brand, but you can bring whichever one you prefer as long as it is not tinted.)
- Square pick-up for removing frisket
- Watercolor pigment in: Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Cerulean Blue, Burnt Sienna
  (Alan prefers to not use the Daniel Smith version of this color), Permanent Alizarin
  Crimson, Yellow Ochre, Aureolin Yellow, Hooker's Green, and Sepia
- A bowl/cup for water
