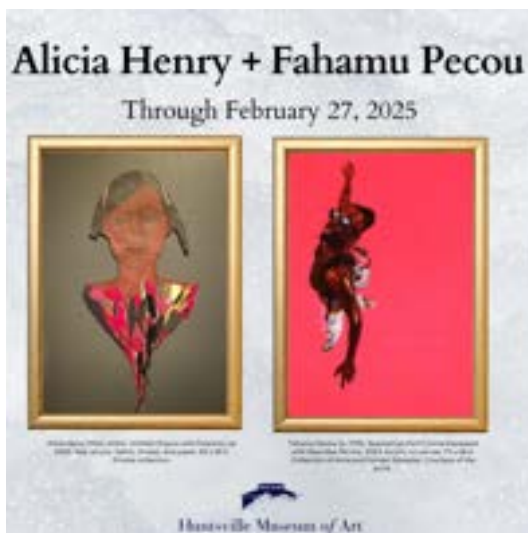

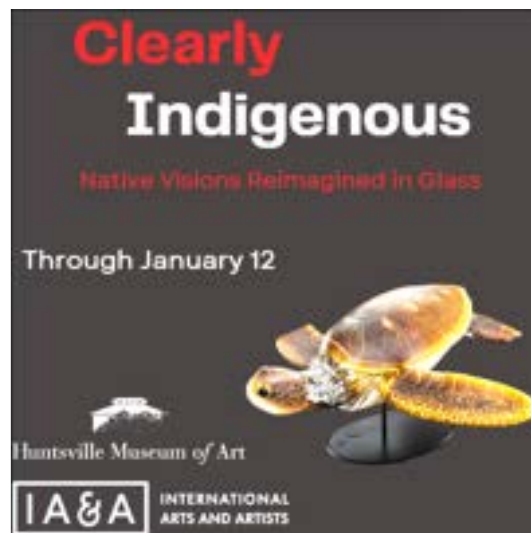
## NOT TO BE MISSED

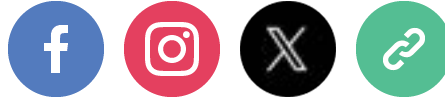
