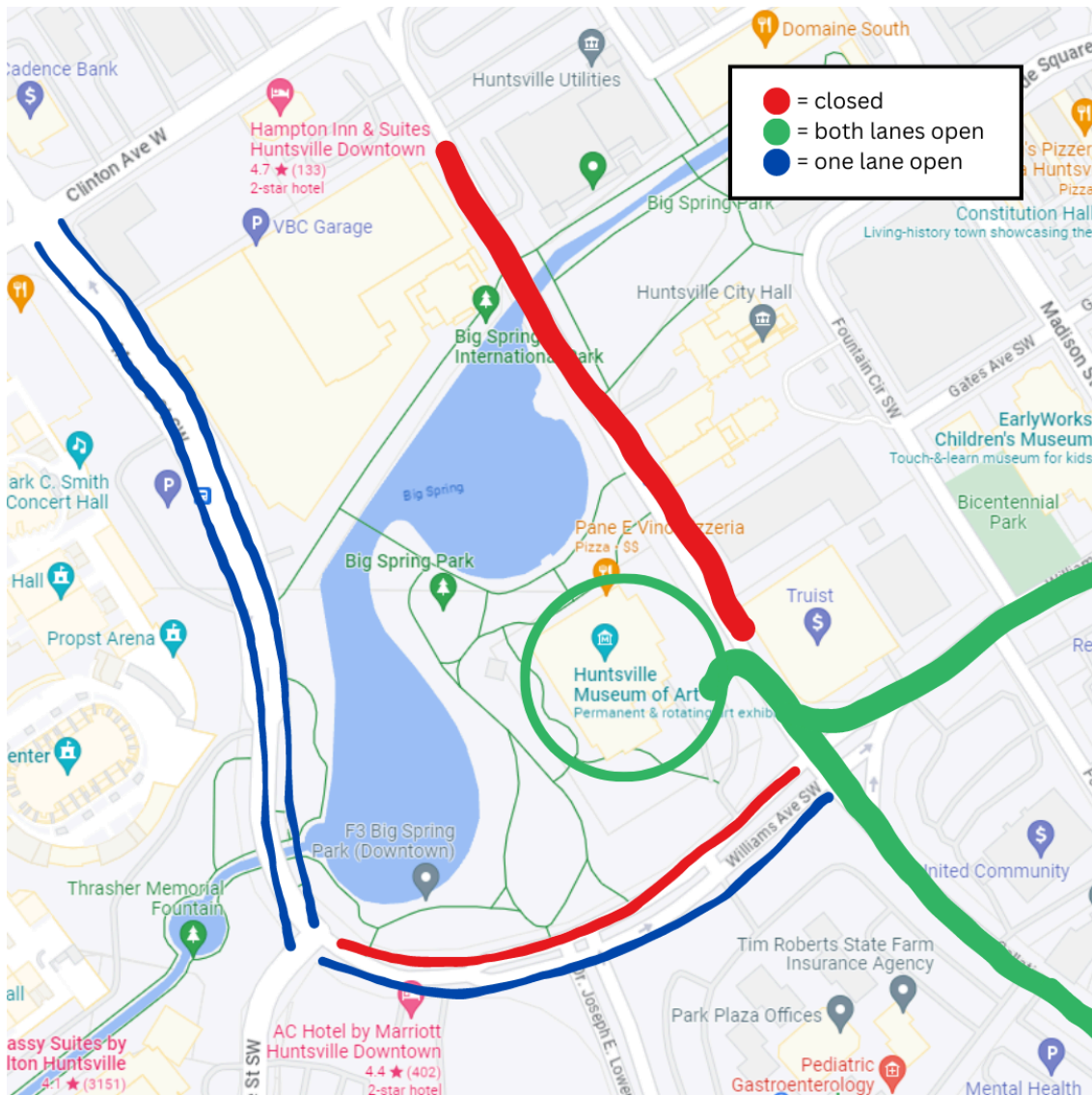

Want to paint more vibrant portraits? Ann Moeller Steverson will teach you how to create beautiful, soft skin tones with a rainbow of natural colors. By enhancing your observational skills and noticing subtleties, you will explore how ambient light affects objects and color. You will learn how to observe the planes of the head, set up attractive and effective lighting, create excellent reference images, and mix paint for more natural-looking colors.

Painting the Figure in the Landscape with Qiang Huang

Thursday, Aug. 17 - Sunday, Aug. 20 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Qiang Huang will introduce his approaches to adding figures into landscape paintings in oil. In general, painting a figure is harder than other subject matter because painters need to know anatomy, proportions, skin tones, and perspective. However, in landscapes, figures are more suggestive. The workshop will emphasize on how to get the correct proportion of human forms into a landscape environment. Students will create storytelling paintings in an expressive style.

Watercolor Painting with Tony Couch

Monday, Sep. 11 - Wednesday, Sep. 13 from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Thursday, Sep. 14 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.



Tony Couch will begin this workshop by completing a painting. He will explain what he is doing and why as he works. Students will paint in the afternoons. At the end of

each day, Couch will critique each work from that day, including his own. An optional slide show about the principles of design, including color and composition, will be presented in the afternoon of the first day.
