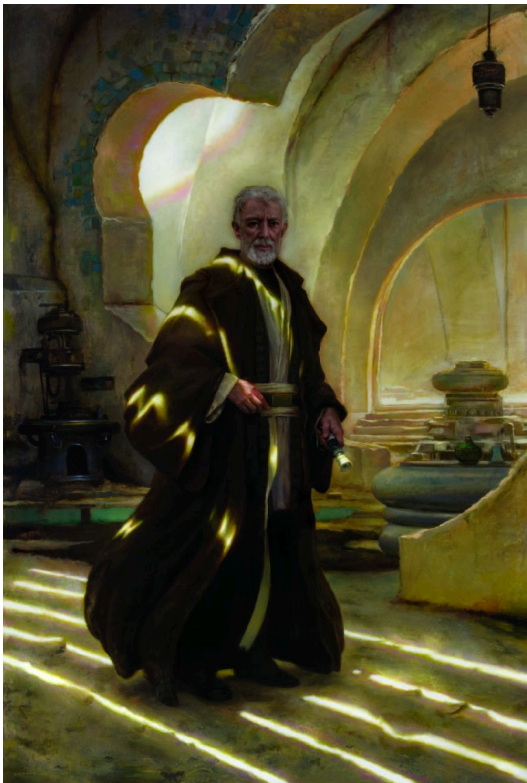

Airbrush Painting Techniques with Alan Pastrana

The Pastrana beginner airbrush course covers the basic principles of airbrushing, along with drills and exercises for airbrush control. This workshop is intended for those who are newcomers or novices with limited or no experience, or those who have some limited experience in airbrushing.
