•**Acrylic Pigments:** (Student grade is acceptable.) (Such brands as Chroma A2 Art Student Acrylics, 4 oz. tubes; Liquitex Basics, 4 oz. tubes or larger; or System 3 Original, 5 oz. tube Alizarin Crimson Hue

•2 – pre-stretched canvases (1-8” x 10” and 1-12” x 16” or larger if you prefer up to 16” x 20”); Disposable Paper Palette; 1 – Rounded Metal Tip Palette Knife (for mixing); Paper Towels

•2 pre-stretched canvases (1-8” x 10” and 1-12” x 16” or larger if you prefer up to 16” x 20”)

•Disposable Paper Palette, 2 Rounded Metal Tip Palette Knives (one for mixing and one for painting); Roll of Paper Towels

•Linseed Oil/Medium; Odorless Solvent/Thinner (Turpenoid or Gamsol [not turpentine]); Metal Container brush cleaning like a metal brush washer with a strainer inside with gasket type of lid attached.
