This year marks the **39th** annual **Youth Art Month (YAM)** exhibition of K-12 student artwork at the Huntsville Museum of Art. The **YAM** and **Congressional Art Competition (CAC)** winner and honorable mentions exhibitions will be on view **March 8-29, 2026**. The YAM and Congressional Art Competition opening will take place on **Sunday, March 8, 2026**.

This exhibition not only showcases the exuberance and vitality of children's art but also underscores the importance of art as an essential subject in students' curriculum. Great art teachers are dedicated to educating students about art history, art criticism, aesthetics, and studio production and ensuring that students are exposed to a variety of art techniques, artists, and materials. YAM 2026 GUIDELINES
FOR
PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS
(HUNTSVILLE CITY, MADISON CITY, AND MADISON COUNTY)

Each elementary art teacher may submit 2 works of art per school (a total of 2 works of art to represent the school). All school entries should be kept together and presented in a portfolio or box. Remember that these are the final artworks that will be hung in the exhibition. **Please attach inventory sheet to the outside of the portfolio or box.**

1. **Entries may be two-dimensional (Maximum 20”x 24”) or three-dimensional to fit on a pedestal or to be hung on the wall.** Artwork does not need to be matted. Works submitted for YAM 2026 will be framed for the exhibit. The frames are the property of the Museum and are not for sale.
2. Work should be selected based on quality, creativity, and presentation. Entries not meeting these standards will not be accepted.
3. **No Xerox, ditto, copied, or traced works will be accepted for exhibition in YAM 2026.** (*Defined as a work of art that is copied from a published photograph, magazine, book illustration, web site, other artwork, or by another person.*)
As the art teacher, I further give my permission for publication of my student's work for publicity and archival purposes only, both in print and on-line. The Huntsville Museum of Art is not responsible for loss, damage or breakage.
4. **No group works** will be accepted due to space limitations.
5. Artwork **will not contain organic materials** (i.e. food products).
6. **All entries must have a completed YAM entry form securely attached to the back of the artwork.** Please be sure the information is accurate and complete. Many students never receive notice that they are in the show because the entry form has incorrect information on it.

YAM selections for ALL Elementary Schools (public city, county, and private schools DOES NOT include Homeschool organizations) will be accepted here at the Museum Academy Studio I located on pondside at Big Spring Park on **Wednesday, February 11, 2026 from 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Look for directional signs. **No entries will be accepted after these times.** (You may also submit your entries early by dropping them off at our Admissions Desk in the Museum Lobby.)**
