Acrylic Painting: Clouds, Trees & Fields, Friday & Saturday, May 15 & 16 from 10 a.m.-4 p.m.
(one-hour lunch break each day)

Golden brand Fluid Acrylics. Lucy recommends them highly! These paints come in a small 1 oz. bottles that are more economical than the larger ones. If you are just getting started with these paints, she recommends you start with this small size.

However, she encourages you to bring whatever acrylic paint you have! You'll need these colors:

Paint

Titanium White
Ultramarine Blue
Yellow Ochre
Cadmium Yellow Medium (or similar primary yellow)
Sap Green
Quinacridone Magenta
Cerulean Blue Deep
Teal
Raw Umber
Pyrrrole Red

Gesso – Lucy likes Jerry's Artarama brand.

Satin Glazing Liquid by Golden

Brushes:

Flats or brights-these have a straight edge
One or two brushes that measure one inch
One or two brushes that measure one half inch
One quarter inch brush
One two-inch brush - can be a craft style brush

Canvases or canvas panels
