Supply List

Note: The instructor has suggested the following art materials for you to acquire for your class.

High School & Adult Classes

Watercolor, 4 Fridays, September 25, October 2, 16, 23 from 10 a.m.-1 p.m.

- **Paper** – Arches cold press 140 lb. full sheet (2) or Canson XL 140 lb., full sheet (2)
- **Paint Brushes** – No. 10 round and ¾” or 1” flat. If you are unsure, the instructor will have extra brushes for students. DO NOT buy very cheap brushes.

- **Paints**

Recommended brands:

- Holbein
- M. Graham and Co.
- Daniel Smith extra fine watercolors
- Windsor and Newton Professional watercolor

- **Colors**

The instructor emphasizes on value (varieties of dark and light) rather than different colors. If you have trouble finding exact colors, please don't worry. Similar colors usually work fine, and the instructor will provide a small amount of them.

- Burnt umber and/or burnt sienna
- Sepia or Neutral tint or Payne's gray
- Sap green or olive green
- Yellow Ochre
- Pale Yellow or Lemon Yellow or Yellow light
- Dioxazine Purple (optional)
- Alizarin Crimson or similar
- Ultramarine Blue or Cobalt Blue or Prussian Blue
- Cadmium Red or similar

- **Palette**

Masters International Folding watercolor palette or similar

(Make sure there is enough space for mixing colors.)

- Masking Tapes (Neutral color is preferred.)
- Paper Towels
- Backing boards will be provided during class time. Or you may want to purchase a drawing board at least 12” x 16” or larger.

Museum Academy will provide backing boards and water containers.
